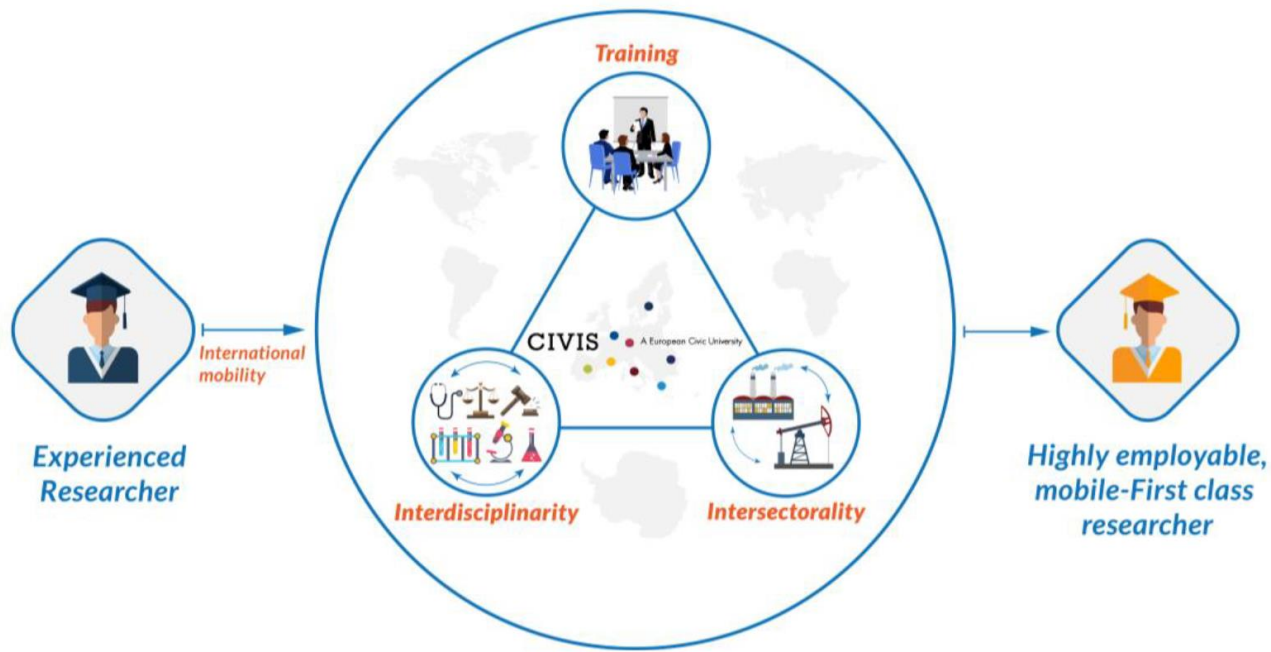

Who can apply?



The CIVIS3i programme is open to researchers of any nationality and age, and representing all research fields



CIVIS3i Candidates must have a doctoral degree



... or at least 4 years of full time equivalent research experience

Diploma enabling to embark on a doctoral programme + confirmation of research experience



They must comply with the MSCA mobility rule

No more than 12 months between 27 October 2019 and 27 October 2022

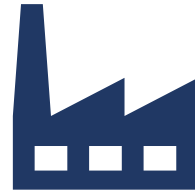


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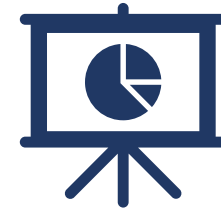

Triple supervision



- CIVIS3i fellows will be supervised by a team of three individuals: one main advisor, a co-advisor, and a secondment mentor
- **Advisor** is affiliated to the recruiting university (host institute)
- **Co-advisor** is affiliated to the co-host university
- **Secondment mentor** is affiliated/employed by the secondment organization chosen by the candidate (different from co-advisor)
- If co-host institute and secondment are not fully defined at call deadline, can be defined at a later stage
- Advisors must hold at least a PhD degree, be a permanent scientific or academic at one of the CIVIS3i recruiting universities, have experience in supervision, and a career level above that of the postdoctoral fellow

Triple supervision









- **Advisor** is affiliated to the Recruiting University/Host Institute (4 choices)
 - Aix Marseille University
 - Université libre de Bruxelles
 - Sapienza Università di Roma
 - Universidad Autónoma de Madrid

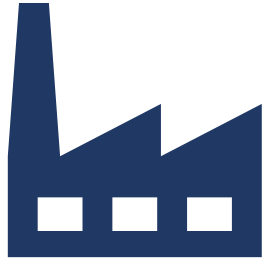
- **Co-advisor** is affiliated to the co-host university (9 choices)
 - Any of 10 CIVIS Universities except the recruiting university

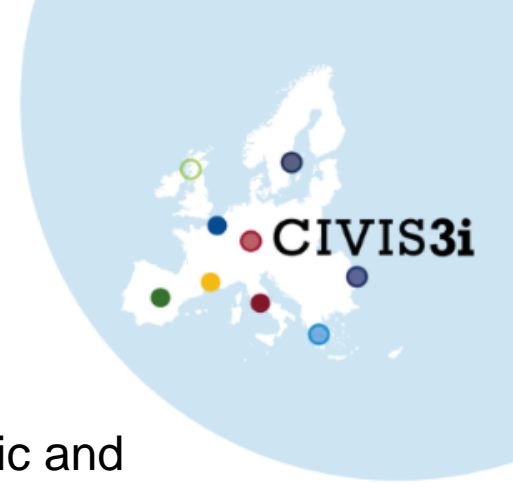
Secondments



- **Research** or **training** visits to another academic or non-academic organization **offering expertise not existing in the host group**
- Support the **intersectoral** and **interdisciplinary** dimensions of the research project and the fellow's **career development**
- Mandatory 3 months secondment; eg 3 x 1 month
- Must be meaningful, justified and helpful to achieve the objectives of the project
- No geographical restriction
- CIVIS3i has a network of 24 partners: <https://civis3i.univ-amu.fr/en/programme-partners>
- Institutions do not bear any costs of the secondment implementation
- Example: dialogue with socio-economic actors, participating in industry networking events contributing to expand the fellow's career prospects, support the research project, the training programme (i.e., career development) or the dissemination...



Role of the advisory team



- Research dimension and a training and career support dimension
- **Advisor** - facilitate the integration of the fellow in the local research environment and support the fellow in achieving the planned scientific and training goals
- Will work closely with the co-advisor and the mentor to ensure a coherent supervision and guidance, especially on training and career development.
- **Co-advisor** - ensure the international and interdisciplinary dimensions of the project
- Will be a researcher with complementary knowledge and expertise that support the CIVIS3i fellow
- Collaboration can be implemented through virtual means, research visits... Number and duration of research visits to the co-host to be defined in accordance to the project's objectives
- **Mentor** - will play a significant role in the career prospects of the fellow, promote access and integration to the socio-economic sector, advise the fellow on training needs, develop an attractive professional profile...

Training



- Two-way transfer of knowledge: Researcher \Leftrightarrow Host institution(s)
- New knowledge the researcher will gain during the fellowship
- Previously acquired skills and knowledge the researcher will transfer to the host
- Contribute to become independent researchers
- **Tip:** See the proposal template instructions

How to apply?



- **Step 1**

- Identify a suitable CIVIS3i Institute and potential advisor
- Obtain a letter of Support
 - signed by the director of institute and by the supervisor
- **Tip:** See template on CIVIS3i website “Call Information” > “Guide for Applicants”
- **Tip:** See the CIVIS3i page “Find an advisor”
- **Tip:** Visit the individual institutes and departments websites “CIVIS3i” > “Partners”, over 200 institutes covering all fields of science

How to apply?



- **Step 2**
 - Register on the submission portal and fill in the online submission form
 - **Tip:** On the CIVIS3i website, look for the **APPLY** button
 - Prepare all the necessary documents

Guide for Applicants

The Guide for Applicants for the first call will help you to prepare your application file. The Guide also provides detailed information about the evaluation and selection procedure, which involves four stages: an eligibility check, a remote expert evaluation, an interview to candidates and a consensus review.

The applicant must identify an advisor within the CIVIS3i Alliance and may obtain an optional letter of acceptance from them (signed by the department/lab director). If the applicant has not yet identified an advisor, they can consult the CIVIS3i Research Inventory "[Find an advisor](#)" or visit the individual Department, Center and Institute web pages (see the Guide for applicants PDF).
